What:

We start in the Czech Republic with lectures on Taiwan's history, foreign policy, trade, and security. We then move to Taiwan, where you'll meet key policymakers, analysts, historians, and cultural experts.

When:

November 28–December 8, 2024

How:

- Study key issues related to Taiwan and EU-Taiwan relations.
- Join a network of journalists with a deep understanding of Taiwan.
- Develop informed reporting on Taiwan-related issues relevant for European readers.

Eligibility:

- Must be a journalist with a news organization from any European region including both EU, non-EU states and Central Asia. Applicants should be professional journalists/editors/producers or freelancers, with demonstrated expertise or interest in international affairs, business, security, or relevant fields.
